Unrestricted Funds

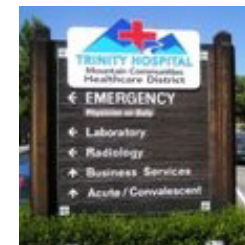
There are no restrictions placed on the gift and can be used at the discretion of the Foundation for health needs in the District.
